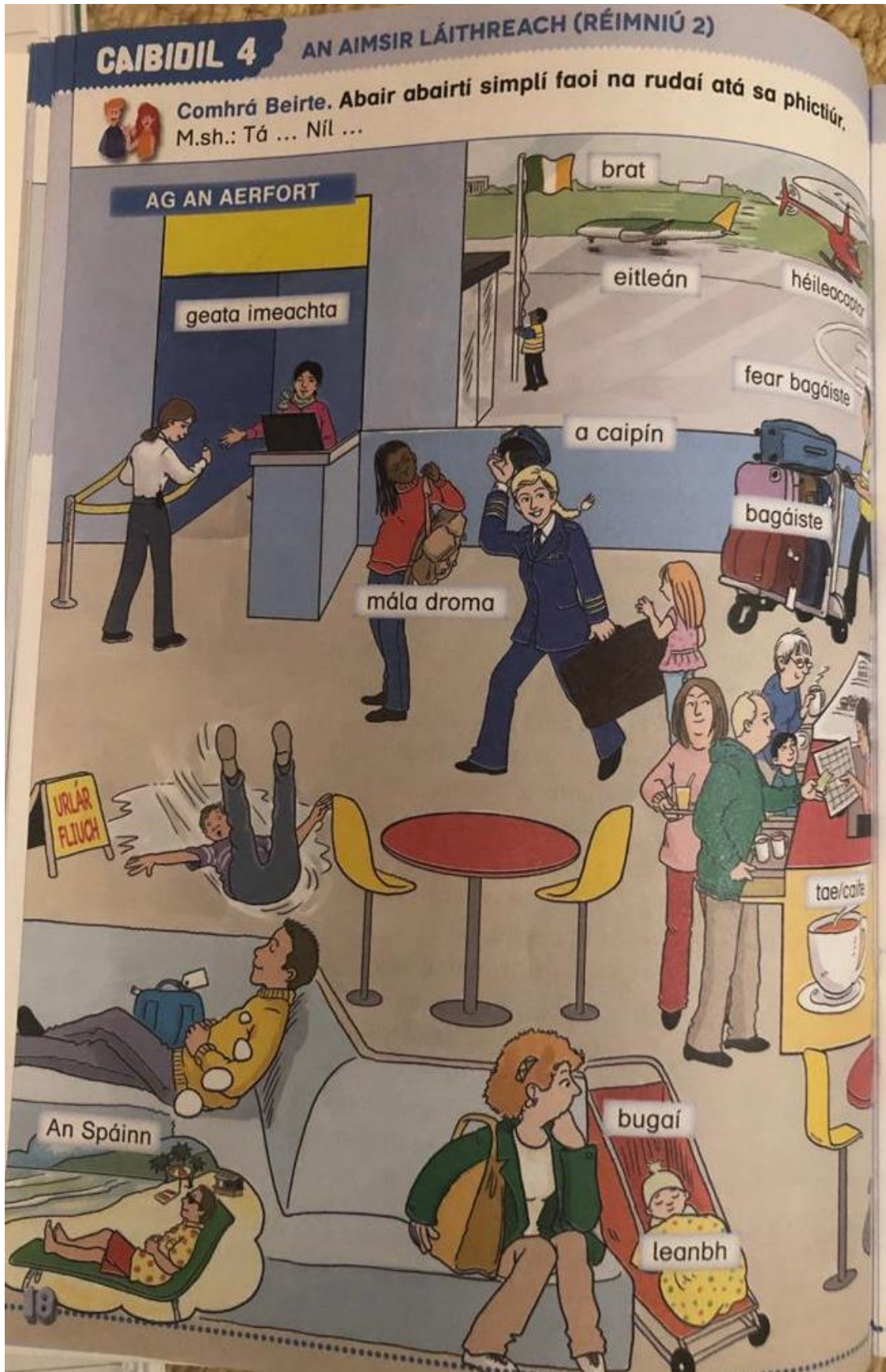

Writing genre: Writing an explanation

An **explanation** usually answers a question. It explains how something works or why something happens.

- The title is often in the form of a question.
- The explanation begins with a sentence to introduce the topic.
- Paragraphs then explain each step.
- Explanations often use cause and effect words.
- Explanations use words about time, for example: after, later, next.
- Diagrams are also used to help explain.

Oral language: Cause and effect

1. Work as a class or group and stand in a circle.
2. One person calls out an effect (something that happened).

Examples: The plant died ...
 The fire went out ...
 The snow melted ...
 A tree fell down ...

3. The next person calls out a cause (why that thing happened).

Examples: ... because I didn't water it.
 ... because I forgot to put wood in it.
 ... when the sun came out.
 ... because there was a storm.

4. If a person can't think of anything to say they must sit down. The winner is the last person left standing.
